1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place prizes in all three categories.

Categories – Any creme pies, fruit pies, and 'other pies' single crust to double crust, all are welcome!

Homemade Pie Contest Rules

- a) This contest is open to bakers of all ages!
- b) Pies must be entered in the name of the person who made it.
- c) Contestants may enter up to three pies.
- d) Each Pie must be made from scratch and based in a 9" 10" <u>disposable</u> pie plate/pan. You may not use pre-made store-bought crust.

Enter a Pie

- a) Bring your Pie to the contest site, at the Platte Area Chamber of Commerce office(512 S Main St), between 9:00 am and 10:00 am on September 24th. At this time your pie will be given an entry number, maintaining confidentiality of the bakers.
- b) Fill out the registration form.
 - i. Acknowledge that the entered pies become the property of the Platte Area Chamber's HayDaze event and that you do not get your pie back.
 - ii. If you win you give your permission to have your photo taken during the announcement ceremony and have it used for Pie Contest and Festival promotional materials.
- c) A copy of your pie recipe, on a 3x5 card or 8x11 paper, with a list of ingredients must be provided with the recipe name, contestant name and phone number, at time of drop off.

Judging

- a) Winners will be announced at 3:00pm.
 - Judges will not be present at the contest tent while pies are delivered to ensure confidentiality of the bakers.
- b) Judging area will be "off limits" to all but Judges and Pie Contest Committee members.
- c) Minimum of three Judges
- d) Criteria Each pie will be judged on the following, out of 95 possible points
 - i. Overall Appearance points 1-20
 - ii. Crust Color, Texture, Doneness, Flavor points 1-20
 - iii. Filling Consistency, Doneness, Moistness, Flavor points 1-20
 - iv. Flavor points 1-20
 - v. Creativity points 1-15
- e) Scoring
 - i. Each judge assigns a numerical value in each criteria category, without consultation with the other judges.
 - ii. The pie receiving the highest total numerical value is the winner. The Pie Contest Committee will tally the judging sheets.
 - iii. In the case of a tie, the judges will judge those pies again.
 - iv. The decision of the judges is final.

Deposition of Pies – all pies become the property of the HayDaze Pie Contest committee. After judging, pies will be sliced and sold to the general public.

Contest continues rain or shine.
